Enjoy your Dog Days of Summer, and I hope to see everyone soon!

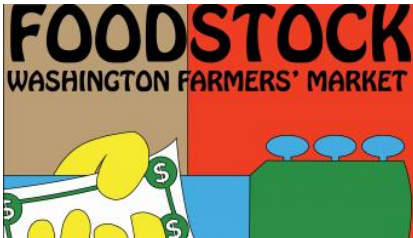
